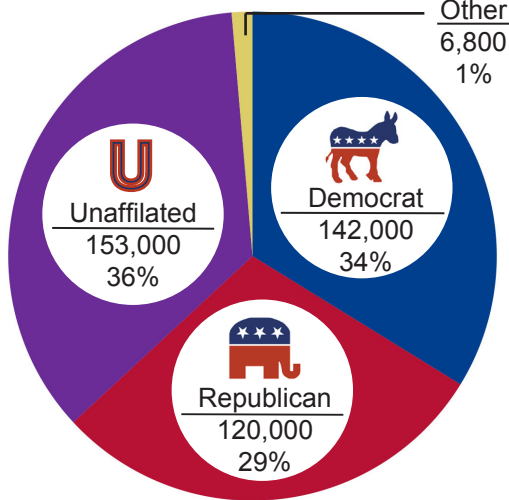

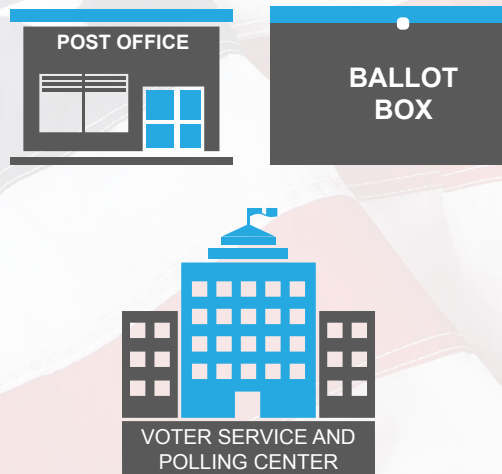

Ballot Design

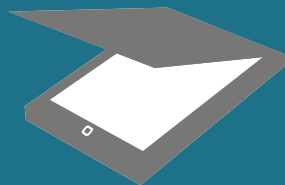
Mail ballots now feature fill-in ovals to mark a vote, instead of arrows.

Ballot Tabulation

Ballots are now tabulated using desktop scanners saving time.



Ballot Adjudication

When a voter's marks are unclear, two bipartisan judges now review the ballot image on a computer to verify a voters ballot choices.



Voting Tablets

Voter Service and Polling Centers now offer new accessible touch-screen tablets and printers for voters to mark and print ballots.
